Creative Dance Center Class Descriptions Winter/Spring 2024 Session

EARLY CHILDHOOD

NURTURING BABY: (2 mo. - pre-walking) A full hour of dance and playtime baby fun! Meaningful social/emotional connections are made as you and baby dance together and with others. Explore dance concepts using multisensory props and instruments and move to a wide variety of music. Learn how to support floor-time. Fun, appropriate movements for baby's developing body & brain. Additional caregivers always welcome.

CAREGIVER/TODDLER: (walking to 2.5) CAREGIVER/CHILD: (2.5-4 yrs.)

CAREGIVER/TODDLER/CHILD: (walking - 5 yrs.)
